RESOLUTION NO. 16-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE TO PLEDGE \$50,000 TO MATCH THE ALLEGHENY COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS THE VIDEO SURVEILLANCE INITIATIVE PROJECT BY ALLEGHENY COUNTY THAT WILL BE USED IN THE MUNICIPALITY TO FIGHT CRIME.

WHEREAS, the Allegheny County District Attorney's Office (ACDA) in conjunction with the Allegheny County Chiefs of Police Association (ACCPA) have recently developed a video surveillance initiative that will be used by Allegheny County to fight crime; and

WHEREAS, the ACDA has identified and located strategic video surveillance checkpoints throughout the County in which drug trafficking and other criminal activities have been used for illicit behavior; and

WHEREAS, due to recent events, the Municipality of Monroeville (Municipality) is eager to update law enforcement surveillance for the safety of the residents and visitors to the Municipality of Monroeville; and

WHEREAS, as such, the Municipality engaged in a dialogue with the Allegheny County District Attorney's Office to review and discuss a Municipal-wide video surveillance system design with Allegheny County; and

WHEREAS, the proposed video surveillance system would become part of the overall county-wide video surveillance system in which the Monroeville Police Department would monitor the Monroeville part of the system; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality, through the Allegheny County District Attorney's Office, agreed to have installed twenty-five (25) high resolution megapixel cameras and four (4) license plate recognition cameras at five (5) locations in Monroeville and one (1) location in Wilkins Township for a total cost of \$165,958.95; and

WHEREAS, the strategic municipal locations would enhance law enforcement efforts in monitoring vehicular traffic entering and exiting the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, for the Municipality of Monroeville to participate in the Allegheny County video surveillance system, the Allegheny County Chiefs of Police Association is requesting a \$50,000 pledge toward the county-wide video surveillance system specifically for the Municipality of Monroeville; and


WHEREAS, in addition, the Monroeville Foundation will pledge \$1,000 towards the efforts of the Monroeville video surveillance system for better law enforcement in the Municipality of Monroeville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipality of Monroeville and the Monroeville Foundation shall pledge \$50,000 and \$1,000 respectively towards the Allegheny County-wide law enforcement video surveillance system by pledging \$50,000 to the Allegheny County Chiefs of Police Association specifically for the Municipality of Monroeville.
