A & L MOTORS

Applicant is requesting Preliminary and Final Subdivision approval of tax parcels 639-D-95, 639-D-99, 638-S-12, 638-S-18 and 638-S-376 to create one parcel, labelled “Lot 1”, with a total lot acreage of 8.008 acres.
